

I CONFERENCE ARCHPRIEST OF HITA & THE MIDDLE AGES A MULTIDISCIPLINARY APPROACH

5-7 JULY 2024, GUADALAJARA (SPAIN)

The multidisciplinary commission of the Chair Archpriest of Hita from Alcalá University is pleased to announce the call for papers for this literary, historical, artistic, and cultural event. This meeting is focused on the study of *The Book of Good Love* (Libro de Buen Amor or LBA), written by the Archpriest of Hita (c.1283-c.1350), and the dissemination of topics related to the Middle Ages.

OBJECTIVE: To provide a meeting space for academics, researchers, students, writers and lovers of medieval society and heritage to deepen knowledge of the Archpriest of Hita's masterpiece and related relevant medieval literature and history.

TOPICS AND PANELS: We invite the submission of papers that address topics related to the following proposals and/or areas:

- 1. The Book of Good Love: Studies, Translation, and Interpretation. Panel: Dr. Soraya García, Modern Philology
- 2. Historical and multicultural context in the Middle Ages. Panel: Dr. Plácido Ballesteros, Medieval History
- 3. Critical reception, analysis, and narrative techniques in the LBA. Panel: Dr. Rocío Díaz, *Philology, Communication and Documentation*
- 4. The Archpriest of Hita as a source of cultural, heritage, artistic and/or didactic inspiration. Panel: Dr. Elena García, Educational Sciences
- 5. Influences, communication, and connections with the LBA. Panel: Dr. Julián de la Fuente, Audiovisual Communication and Advertising

COMMUNICATIONS: each presentation will be up to 15 minutes. Individual and group submissions will be accepted.

SUBMISSION OF PROPOSALS: Those interested in participating should send an email to catedraarcipreste@uah.es with the title and abstract of the paper proposal (maximum 300 words) and indicate their name, surname and institution, along with a brief academic biography (maximum 100 words) before the deadline May 30, 2024. The scientific committee will evaluate the proposals and notify their acceptance to the participants by email before June 15, 2024 so that they can complete the registration. process.

SCIENTIFIC PUBLICATION: The selected complete communications (maximum 20 pages) must be sent before 7-7-2024 to be published in a Book with ISBN edited by the Publications Service of the Provincial Council of Guadalajara, according to the editing rules.

- Friday, July 5, 2024: Opening and presentation of papers.
- Saturday, July 6: Attendance at the <u>62 Medieval Festival of Hita</u> with cultural activities, Medieval Tournament and performance of the play based on the *Book of Good Love*
- Sunday, July 7: Round Table and Closure

REGISTRATION: 35€ per person which includes: the publication of the communications, certificate of participation, conference material, refreshments, the entrance to the Medieval Tournament and the Theatre play based on LBA. Transport to Hita will be facilitated. Free entry to the public subject to availability
